

By-law No. 39.
A Law Respecting House Numbering

Be it enacted by the Town Council of the Town of Woodstock as a By-Law on this twenty-fourth day of August, A.D. 1970, as follows:

1. In case the Town Council shall at any time by resolution to that effect decide that all buildings abutting on streets within the Town shall be numbered the order of such numbering shall be as follows: In case of streets lying east and west the numbers shall run from east to west with odd numbers on the south side and even numbers on the north side of such streets; and in the case of streets lying north and south the numbers shall run from south to north with odd numbers on the west side and even numbers on the east side of such streets. In the case of vacant lots a number shall be allotted for every sixty feet along such vacant lots. All numbering shall be done in accordance with a uniform specification which shall be authorized by the Council.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 1, the streets lying to the east of Main Street shall be numbered with the smallest numbers beginning at Main Street, and the streets lying to the south of Poole Street shall be numbered with the smallest numbers nearest to Poole Street.
