## BY-LAW NO. 602 A BY-LAW RESPECTING THE REMUNERATION OF COUNCIL FOR TOWN OF WOODTOCK

**PURPOSE:** A By-law of TOWN OF WOODSTOCK, in the Province of New Brunswick, for the purpose of establishing the remuneration of the council for TOWN OF WOODSTOCK.

**WHEREAS:** The Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform may make or amend by-laws of a restructured local government as per An Act Respecting Local Governance Reform, section 11(2);

WHEREAS: The enactment of this by-law repeals the following by-law(s);
By-law # A-3, A bylaw Relating to the Proceedings of the Council for the Town of Woodstock.

BE IT ENACTED by the Minister of Local Government and Local Governance Reform as follows:

## 1. REMUNERATION OF THE COUNCIL

- 1.01 The mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$45,000; the amount being payable in equal instalments.
- 1.02 The deputy mayor shall be paid an annual salary of \$22,500; the amounts being payable in equal instalments.
- 1.03 Each councillor shall be paid an annual salary of \$18,000, the amounts being payable in equal instalments.
