- TO REZONE PART OF PID #10171080 (APPROXIMATELY 4.0 ACRES) FROM RURAL OR GREENBELT TO "R-2", ONE, TWO FAMILY AND MULTIPLE RESIDENTIAL.
- AND TO REZONE PID #10080026 FROM RURAL OR GREENBELT TO "R-2", ONE, TWO FAMILY AND MULTIPLE RESIDENTIAL.
- REPORT OF THE PLANNING ADVISORY COMMITTEE DATED APRIL 18, 2005 WAS PRESENTED TO TOWN COUNCIL AT A SPECIAL MEETING DATED APRIL 18, 2005.
- MAPS OF THE AREA AND THE LOTS UNDER CONSIDERATION WERE DISTRIBUTED
