Tim Hortons Wellness Centre reopens June 5th

Hours are: OPEN Monday-Friday 5 am- 8 pm | CLOSED Saturday & Sunday

1. Bookings will be made for one-hour slots for a maximum of eight (8) people at a time. The slots available are: 5:15am-6:15 am | 6:45 am-7:45 am | 8:15 am- 9:15 am | 11:15 am- 12:15 am | 12:45 pm-1:45 pm | 2:15 pm- 3:15 pm |3:45 pm- 4:45 pm | 5:15 pm- 6:15 pm | 6:45-7:45 pm. *First Come, First Served.* You will pre-book your slot with receptionist by email ONLY at <u>ayrmotorcentre@town.woodstock.nb.ca</u>. Emails are monitored between the hours of 5 am- 7 pm, Monday to Friday. **All cancellations must be done 48 hours in advance.**

2. You will receive an updated health confidential form to complete, **you will need to bring this with you on your first visit or email back ahead of time.** This MUST be completed before entering the fitness centre.

3. Anyone entering the AYR Motor Centre is required to complete a temperature check when they arrive and check in at the reception desk. The Receptionist will use a touchless temperature reader that will register your forehead temperature. To be admitted into the Centre, you must register a temperature of 38 degrees Celsius or below (100.4F).

4. Upon arrival, every member will be provided their own individual disinfectant spray dispenser & microfibre cloth when checking-in. This is to be used for cleaning equipment before and after each use. **Please spray disinfectant into the cloth to apply to equipment or machine**. The disinfectant & cloth must be returned to the black cart upon exiting the building.

5. Equipment use will be limited to one apparatus at a time. Super Sets using multiple machines will not be permitted.

6. During this time no spotting will be permitted so modify your workout to ensure you are only lifting what you can manage safely.

7. Locker Room **will not** be available for use at this time so please limit what you bring to the fitness centre. One bag per customer is permitted and will be left on the floor in the designated area of the fitness centre.

8. Only the refill station will be used to FILL water bottle for your workout.

9. To reduce droplets transmission and for everyone's added safety, Members must practice physical distancing of a minimum 6 feet. **This will be strictly enforced.**

10. Showers will not be available for use, based on current Public Health Authority restrictions. The upstairs washroom is open however no personal items are to be left behind.

11. We will have signs posted throughout the Centre reminding members to maintain a minimum physical distancing of 6 feet, and to clean equipment Before & After use.

Accessing the Facility

Wash your hands in the main lobby washroom with warm soapy water.

Members will be asked to enter through the main front door & exit by side door beside the elevator. Remove outdoor shoes & place them in a cubby.

Be dressed to work out upon entering the building

The doors will be open throughout the facility.

Social distancing must be practiced at all times

Follow the arrows to take you to your designated space & to exit the building once your workout is complete.

Guidelines are posted throughout the facility using appropriate signage. Please be sure to take the time to review all signage and direct any questions you may have to a member of our team.

- All materials must be returned through the book drop at the rear of the building off the Chapel Street parking lot.


