By-law Z-1
A By-law to Establish a Planning Advisory Committee

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Woodstock, under the authority vested in it by the Community Planning Act, SNB 2017, c19 as follows:

Purpose and Intent

1. To provide clarity and direction on the establishment, operation, and terms of the members to ensure a proper balance of history, continuity, and active engagement occurs.

Advisory Committee Established

1. The Council of the Town of Woodstock hereby establishes a committee to be known as the Planning Advisory Committee which shall advise the Council on matters of planning.
2. The committee shall be composed of eight (8) members.
3. No more than two (2) members appointed to the Planning Advisory Committee may be members of Council.

Term

1. Terms of appointment for members serving on the Planning Advisory Committee shall be in accordance with the requirements of the Community Planning Act.

Constitution

1. The Planning Advisory Committee shall adopt a constitution and may from time to time amend the Constitution so long as the provisions therein do not conflict with the Community Planning Act, Local Governance Act, or the by-laws of the Town of Woodstock.
2. The Constitution shall be reviewed by the Planning Advisory Committee at least once every four (4) calendar years.
