AQUATICS SUPERVISOR

Primary job duties include but are not limited to planning and organizing pool activities and programs; hiring and training staff to meet operational demands; overseeing instructors and leading roll-out and development of aquatic programs; supervisory support for training classes and school lessons; ensure maintenance/cleanliness of the pool to meet safety and service level requirements; monitor adherence to all occupational health and safety protocols for the aquatic facility, in accordance with operational standards and departmental guidelines; maintain and organize files and record keeping; support the Town of Woodstock Recreation team with other departmental programs and services as needed. The Aquatics supervisor may be required to work ooccasional weekends, evenings and holidays. He or she will be comfortable with frequent and ongoing interaction with the public.
